

In 2021 Marianne Kaurins novel "Irgendwo ist immer Süden" received the state-sponsored **German Children's Literature Award** (Deutscher Jugendliteraturpreis). The prize ceremony was held at the Frankfurt Book Fair, and we feel greatly honoured that our author received this renowned award.

Following this success, WooW Books is releasing the heart-warming novel **How I Found Pepa and Got my Happiness Back** about a little boy, taking on the duty of a secret agent for wish fulfilling. 
# Presenting 20 celebrity authors of children's literature


# Niki and Flo are Unstoppable
